

Steps for Readmission for Disqualified Students

Redmission Criteria

- Students who are academically disqualified from Fresno State are required to be out for at least two semesters after their disqualification. Students must demonstrate academic improvement by completing courses through Fresno State Open University or any other regionally accredited institution.
- Students must complete all lower division general education (GE) requirements.
- Students who have already completed lower division GE before leaving Fresno State must complete a minimum of 6 units of degree applicable work using a combination of either major or GE courses. (Fall applicants cannot use summer course work prior to the term student is reapplying).
- A student's overall transfer work after disqualification must be a minimum 2.50 GPA and needs to be in good academic standing at the last institution attended.
 - Fall applicants must have graded coursework of a 2.50 GPA by end of fall term prior to admission. All requirements must be completed by end of spring prior to the fall term of admissions.
 - Spring applicants must have graded coursework of 2.50 GPA by end of spring term prior to admissions. All requirements by end of summer prior to the spring term of admissions.
- Students who wish to return and pursue a different major must meet the impactation criteria for that major if there is a criteria. If they are returning in the same major, if impacted, they can be readmitted without meeting the impactation criteria.

- Courses appear on Fresno State transcript.

Community College

- Apply to community college.
- Complete all lower division general education.
- Complete all lower division major course work.
- Complete career related course work.
- Send official transcripts.

Admissions Application Process

- Apply for readmission at my.fresnostate.edu during the application filing period.
 - Fall application cycle (October 1st- January 15th) *
 - Spring application cycle (August 1st- August 31st) *
- After submitting an application, students must submit official transcripts by [document deadline](#).
 - Fall document deadline- February 1st * & Spring document deadline- September 15th *
 - A student who has not attended Fresno State in 5 or more years must submit all official transcripts from previous institutions.
 - A returning student who attended another college or institute after their last semester at Fresno State must submit all official transcripts from those institutions.
- Student may be asked to complete a Readmission Petition by the Admissions office via email.
- Applications will be reviewed by a committee. Students will be notified of their admissions prior to the semester beginning.
