

Steps for Readmission for Disqualified Students

Readmission Criteria

- Students who are academically disqualified from Fresno State are required to be out for a minimum of one semester after their disqualification (summer not included). Students must demonstrate academic improvement by completing courses through Fresno State Open University or any other regionally accredited institution.
- o Complete one of the following course options through a regionally accredited institution (6 units minimum):
 - a. General Education (GE) foundation (Area A and B4) requirements*
 - b. If the foundation is complete, take 6 units of other remaining GE requirements
 - c. If all lower division GE coursework has been completed, take at least 6 units of degree or career-applicable CSU transferable coursework. (This may include upper-division coursework taken through Open University).

*Options b or c are only available if the student completes option a.

Note: (Fall applicants cannot use summer course work prior to the term student is reapplying).

d.

- A student's overall transfer work after disqualification must be a minimum 2.30 GPA and needs to be in good academic standing at the last institution attended.
 - a. Fall applicants must have graded coursework of a 2.30 GPA by end of fall term (winter intersession may be considered) prior to admission. All requirements must be completed by end of spring prior to the fall term of admissions.
 - b. Spring applicants must have graded coursework of 2.30 GPA by end of summer term prior to admissions. All requirements by end of summer prior to the spring term of admissions.

Open University

- Receive a permission number from professor.
- Pay fees (per units) and additional course fees.
- Courses appear on Fresno State transcript.

Community College

- Apply to community college.
- Complete all foundation general education.
- If foundation GE is completed, complete 6 units of lower division GE course work.
- If lower division GE is complete 6 units of CSU trasnferable course work.
- · Send official transcripts.

Admissions Application Process

- Apply for readmission at <u>my.fresnostate.edu</u> during the application filing period. The application is located under the "My Admissions" drop down in your Student Center. NOTE: Students who last attended Fresno State more than 10 years will need to apply through <u>Calstate.edu/apply</u>.
 - o Fall application cycle (October 1st- January 15th) *
 - o Spring application cycle (August 1st- August 31st) *
- Students must submit official transcripts by document deadline.
 - Fall document deadline- January 15th * & Spring document deadline- September 16th *
 - A student who has not attended Fresno State in 5 or more years must submit all official transcripts from previous institutions.
 - A returning student who attended another college or institute after their last semester at Fresno State must submit all
 official transcripts from those institutions.
- o Students will need to complete a Readmission Petition by the document deadline.
 - o Fall document deadline- January 15th * & Spring document deadline- September 16th *
- o Applications will be reviewed by a committee. Students will be notified of their admissions prior to the semester beginning.
