

Steps for Readmission for Good Standing and Probation

Readmission Criteria

- Students who left in good academic standing or probation and are seeking readmission after an absence of two consecutive or more semesters (summer not included) may reapply for admissions.
- No additional admission criteria are needed for returning students who left in good or probation academic standing at Fresno State.
- Students who wish to return and pursue a different major may need to meet GPA or other criteria for the major. If students are returning in the same major, even if impacted, they can be readmitted into the major.

Admissions Application Process

- Apply for readmission at my.fresnostate.edu during the application filling period. The application is located under the “My Admissions” drop down in your Student Center. NOTE: Students who last attended Fresno State more than 10 years will need to apply through [Calstate.edu/apply](https://calstate.edu/apply).
 - Fall application cycle (October 1st- January 15th) *.
 - Spring application cycle (August 1st-August 31st) *.
- Students must submit official transcripts by [document deadline](#).
 - Fall document deadline- January 15th * & Spring document deadline- September 16th *
 - A student who has not attended Fresno State in 5 or more years must submit all official transcripts from previous institutions.
 - A returning student who attended another college or institute after their last semester at Fresno State must submit all official transcripts from those institutions.
- Applications will be reviewed by Admissions & Recruitment. Students will be notified of their admissions prior to the semester beginning.
