

CSU Policy Recommendations for Prevention Programs and Committees

Recommendation #1: First and foremost, CSU Presidents must make this issue a priority in a demonstrable manner. The "Be Vocal, Be Visible, Be Visionary" statement from the Presidents' Leadership Group formed by the Higher Education Center for Alcohol and Other Drug Prevention is an example of what the committee envisions;

Recommendation # 2: All campuses should develop comprehensive policies that are consistently enforced;

Recommendation # 3: Prevention and education programs must be offered by a well-trained staff;

Recommendation # 4: Students must be involved in policy planning and execution to a significant degree;

Recommendation # 5: Treatment programs must be available for those students who need this assistance; and

Recommendation # 6: Data must be gathered systematically to determine the nature and extent of the problem as well as the success of policies and programs.
