- 5. Submit a check or money order for a \$16 participation fee.
- 6. Acceptance to an accredited post-secondary school (submit official college acceptance letter)
- 7. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 (submit official transcript).
- 8. List all extracurricular activities, honors or special recognition, community service, work experience, and post-high-school plans.
- 9. Submit a 500-word essay on the importance of giving back to your community. Additionally, please describe ways you have engaged and made meaningful contributions to your community.
