ENGLISH EXEMPTION REQUEST

California State University, Fresno has received results from California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP), SAT or ACT test score for English. The results have placed the student as “**Conditional Exempt**”.

In order to clear the “**Conditional Exempt**” status the student must have completed a one-year course in English and earned a grade of “C” or better *during the student’s senior year*.

- English course approved for extra honors credit by the University of California

Students **not** completing the senior year experience (SYE) English requirement **may be required** to take a stretch General Education English course. Additional major requirements will be covered during Dog Days Orientation.
