WHAT IS CAMP?

C.A.M.P. is a federally funded program designed to provide support and retention services to students who have been admitted to the university and are either migrant or from farmworking families.

TWO WAYS TO QUALIFY:

Students must be First-Time Freshmen at Fresno State.

You or your parent(s)/legal guardian(s) must have performed seasonal agriculture labor (fieldwork, packing house, dairies, poultry/livestock production, fishing) for at least 75 days within the past two years;

OR

Participation in the Migrant Education Program (MEP) anytime during K-12.
