

Department of Homeland Security (INS) SUMMARY CHART of ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTATION

All documents submitted must be original. If you are having trouble obtaining INS documents, you may use a G-639 to request photocopies of the original documentation.

CITIZEN NOT BORN IN UNITED STATES

- ◆ **Certificate of Citizenship:** *Must have student's name on certificate and date certificate was issued*
- ◆ **Certificate of Naturalization:** *Must have student's name, certificate number, signature, Alien Registration Number, name of court with date where Naturalization occurred.*
- ◆ **"Certificate of Birth Abroad":** *Must have embossed seal "United States of America" and "State Department."*
FS-545, DS-1350, or FS-240,
"Report of Birth Abroad"
- ◆ **U.S. Passport**

NON-CITIZEN NATIONAL

- ◆ **U.S. Passport:** *Must be stamped "Non Citizen National."*

PERMANENT RESIDENT

- ◆ **"Alien Registration Receipt: Card" Form 1-151, 1-551, or 1-551C** *The 1-1551 must have a current valid expiration date.*
- ◆ **Passport:** *Must be stamped "Processed for 1-551" with expiration date.*
- ◆ **"Arrival Departure Record" (I-94):** *Must be stamped as a "Processed for I-551" with expiration date or "Temporary Form I-551", with appropriate information filled in*

OTHER ELIGIBLE NON-CITIZEN

- ◆ **"Arrival Departure Record" (I-94):** *Must be stamped as a "Refugee", "Asylum Status", "Conditional Form I-94 Entrant (before April 1, 1980) "Parolee" or "Cuban-Haitian Entrant"*
