The Federal TEACH Grant program provides grant funds to students who are completing coursework needed to begin a career in teaching. The student agrees to serve for at least four years as a full-time, highly qualified teacher in a high-need field in a school serving low-income students. Eligible full-time students may be eligible to receive up to \$1,876 per semester in TEACH Grant funds.

If you receive a TEACH Grant but do not complete the required teaching service requirements, all TEACH Grant funds will be converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan that you must repay, with accrued interest, to the Department of Education. **Once a TEACH Grant is converted to a loan, it cannot be converted back to a grant.**

Priority Deadlines: In order to allow enough time to process a grant request before the end of the academic term, we have established the following deadlines:

Fall 2019 only: November 15, 2019

Academic year/Spring 2020 only: April 17, 2020

Summer 2020: June 12, 2020

TEACH GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Specify your current academic degree objective: Undergraduate Teaching Credential Masters
- Complete the TEACH Grant Request Form and submit it to the Financial Aid Office.
- Submit a signed Education Plan from your advisor/department head, who is familiar with your teaching program/career goals to the Financial Aid Office. The Education Plan must be on Fresno State department/school letterhead.
- Complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2018-2019.
- Meet first-year TEACH Grant determination GPA requirements.
 - First Semester Undergraduates: Must have a final high school cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher to be eligible.
 - First Semester Graduates: Must have an undergraduate cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher to be eligible.
- Maintain a 3.25 minimum cumulative GPA in your current academic program for subsequent year TEACH Grant requests.
- Be enrolled in an eligible program in (specify requested term): FALL 2019 SPRING 2020 SUMMER 2020
- Complete the TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve (ATS). *This must be completed each academic year for each new TEACH Grant.*
- Complete TEACH Grant Counseling. *This must be completed each academic year for each new TEACH Grant.*
- Be enrolled in a high-need field/program that leads towards teaching in a public or private elementary or secondary school that serves students from low-income families.
