The Federal TEACH Grant program provides grant funds to students who are completing coursework needed to begin a career in teaching. The student agrees to serve for at least four years as a full-time, highly qualified teacher in a high-need field in a school serving low-income students. Eligible full-time students may be eligible to receive up to \$1,886 per semester in TEACH Grant funds, with a maximum academic year award of \$3,772.

If you receive a TEACH Grant but do not meet the requirements of your service obligation, all TEACH Grants you received will be converted to Direct Unsubsidized Loans. You must repay these loans in full, with interest charged from the date of each TEACH Grant disbursement. See the link below for additional details.

In order to be eligible, you must:

- Complete the current Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and meet the basic eligibility criteria for federal student aid programs
- Maintain a 3.25 minimum cumulative GPA
- Be enrolled in a TEACH-Grant eligible program. Note: Only the Undergraduate Integrated Teacher Education Program (ITEP),
 Undergraduate Mathematics Integrated Credential Option program, Education Specialist Credential, and CalStateTEACH (CST)
 Credential are eligible for the TEACH Grant.
- Sign the TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve or Repay (ATS) and complete the TEACH Grant Counseling at studentaid.gov
- Be enrolled in a high-need field/program that leads towards teaching in a public or private elementary or secondary school that serves students from low-income families. programs are eligible for the TEACH Grant
