

Transfer Entitlement Cal Grant Verification Form

The California Student Aid Commission requires the Financial Aid Office to obtain documentation that verifies you have met the following eligibility requirements before you may receive your Transfer Entitlement Cal Grant award:

- Graduated from a California High School or have completed a high school graduation equivalency (including GED or the California High School Proficiency Exam) on or after July 1,
And be a California resident at the time of your high school graduation or its equivalent,
- Or**
- Did not graduate from high school or its equivalent on or after July 1, , but were a California resident on your 18th birthday.

Read the following carefully, then submit this completed form and all requested documents to the **Financial Aid Office, Attention: Cal Grant Coordinator**, as soon as possible.

Failure to return this form within 30 days could adversely affect your ability to be considered for a Cal Grant award.

Section A:

California High School Graduate (or completed an equivalency)

18 years old (or older) at the time of high school graduation:

Submit a copy of your California high school transcript that shows your graduation date or proof of equivalency.

17 years old (or younger) at the time of high school graduation:

Submit a copy of your high school transcript **and** one of the following:

- a) A copy of your parent's (or legal guardian's) California state tax return for the tax year immediately prior to your high school graduation or its equivalent (for example, a 2023 California state tax return if you graduated in 2024).
- b) If your parent (or legal guardian) did not file a California state tax return for the year requested, your parent (or legal guardian) must provide one of the following documents for the calendar year immediately prior to your high school graduation or its equivalent.
 - California lease or rental agreement
 - California utility bill
 - California voter registration
 - California auto registration

Section B:

**Did not graduate from high school or its equivalent on or after July 1,
but you were a California resident on your 18th birthday.**
