Fall 2022 Disbursement Information

Fall aid will begin disbursing the week of August 15th.

Here are a couple of things you need to keep in mind:

- If you have any financial aid To Do items or Holds on your Student Center, these may keep your aid from being awarded and/or disbursed. Take care of them ASAP!
- Financial aid is disbursed based on the number of units you are enrolled in - waitlisted units do not count.
 - 12+ units = Full Time
 - 9-11 units = Three Quarter Time
 - 6-8 units = Half Time
 - 1-5 units = Less Than Half Time
- Financial aid is finalized based on your enrollment as of September 19th. To avoid any confusion or frustration, we recommend finalizing your schedule as early as possible.

DELAYS IN AID DISBURSEMENT:

- Open To Do items and holds will delay your aid from disbursing. Please note that processes can take several weeks to get through so submit information as soon as possible.
- If you were enrolled in Summer 2022 courses, your financial aid will be delayed until we are able to confirm that you are maintaining your financial aid eligibility (see right column for more information).
- If you had a previously approved SAP appeal, your financial aid will be delayed until we confirm that you are maintaining the conditions of your SAP appeal approval (see right column for more information).

Reminder: Financial aid will adjust based on your enrollment until the Census date. Census for Fall 2022 is September 19th and your financial aid will be finalized based on your enrollment as of this day.



2022-2023 PROCESSING

If you haven't completed your 2022-2023 FAFSA or California Dream Act Application yet, it is not too late!

Please note that we are working as quickly as possible to get students through the financial aid process, awarded, and aid disbursed.

DID YOU ENROLL IN SUMMER 2022 CLASSES?

If you were enrolled in Summer 2022 classes, your financial aid for Fall 2022 will be slightly delayed.

Every semester, we have to ensure that you are maintaining your financial aid eligibility based on the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements. The SAP process will run after summer grades are official on August 17th. If you are not meeting our SAP policy, you will receive an email notification and a To Do Item on your Student Center for submitting an appeal. Financial aid cannot be disbursed until an appeal has been submitted and approved. Click here for more information about the SAP Policy and Appeal Process.

HAVE YOU PREVIOUSLY COMPLETED A SAP APPEAL?

If you submitted a SAP appeal in a previous semester and it was approved, we must review your progress and ensure you are meeting the conditions of your approval before your fall aid can disburse. If you have not received an update by September 9th, please contact our office.
