

SPRING 2023 FEE PAYMENT INFORMATION

Student Accounts has set the Spring 2023 Fee Payment Deadline as January 5th.

To avoid being dropped from courses, make sure your fees are paid in full, you have a payment plan set up (and you've made the first payment), or a spring fee deferment in place by January 5th.

ALREADY HAVE A FEE DEFERMENT?

If you already have a spring fee deferment, you do not need to request another one.

REQUESTING SPRING FEE DEFERMENTS

- Log into your Student Center
- Go to the My Finances section
- Click the dropdown box and select "Fin Aid Fee Deferment Request" and then the double arrows.
- Complete and submit the form!

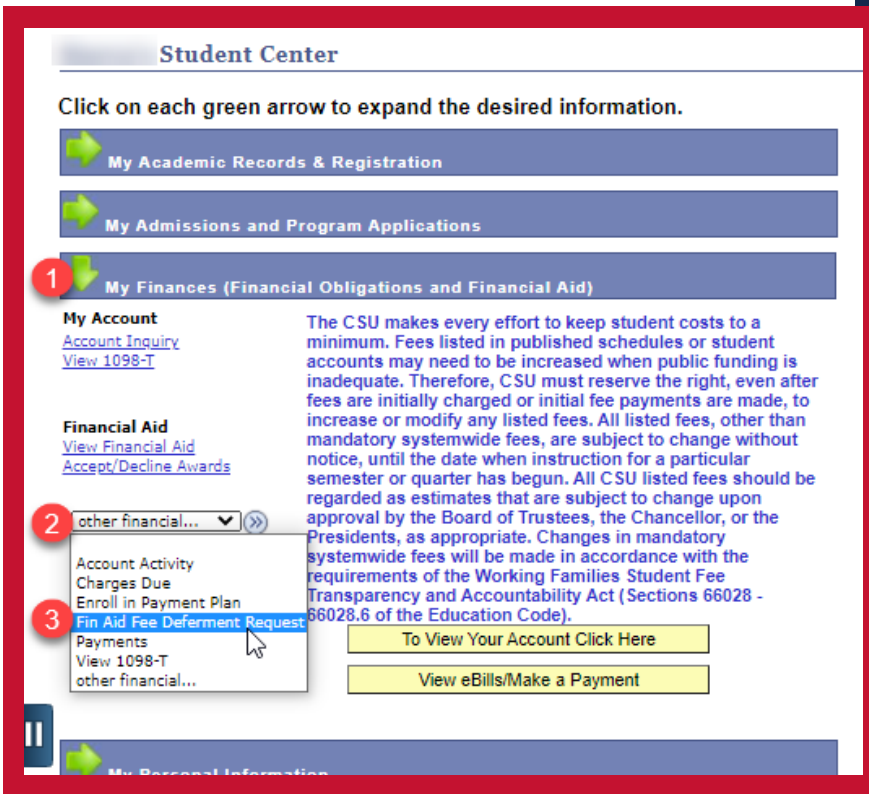
IMPORTANT: Financial Aid Fee Deferment requests will not be accepted via e-mail or live chat.

AVAILABILITY DATES

The Spring Fee Deferment Request will be available on January 3, 2023 through January 5, 2023 at 5:00PM PST.

MORE INFORMATION:

- Some students are automatically given a fee deferment if they meet certain criteria. To view the fee deferment eligibility requirements, click here.
- **Spring Fee Deferment Requests:** You can request a Spring Financial Aid Fee Deferment from your Student Center. See instructions to the left for information on how to request from your Student Center. You will hear back on your request before the Fee Payment Deadline.
 - **YOU CANNOT SUBMIT THE FINANCIAL AID FEE DEFERMENT REQUEST (to the left) IF...**
 - You already have a spring financial aid fee deferment.
 - You have already submitted a request and it has not yet been reviewed.



FINANCIAL AID DISBURSEMENTS

Financial aid will begin disbursing the week before the spring classes start.

Requesting the fee deferment through the Student Center is the best and fastest way to request a financial aid fee deferment.

Spring 2023 Disbursement Information

Spring aid will begin disbursing the week of January 9th.

Here are a couple of things you need to keep in mind:

- **If you have any financial aid To Do items or Holds on your Student Center, these may keep your aid from being awarded and/or disbursed.** Take care of them ASAP!
- **Financial aid is disbursed based on the number of units you are enrolled in** - waitlisted units do not count.
 - 12+ units = Full Time
 - 9-11 units = Three Quarter Time
 - 6-8 units = Half Time
 - 1-5 units = Less Than Half Time
- **Financial aid is finalized based on your enrollment as of Census, on February 15th.** To avoid any confusion or frustration, we recommend finalizing your schedule as early as possible.
- **The Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) process will run after fall grades are official.** Grades are due on January 3rd, and should be official a few days later. If you are not meeting our SAP policy, you will receive an email notification and a To Do Item on your Student Center for submitting an appeal. Financial aid cannot be disbursed until an appeal has been submitted and considered for approval. [Click here for more information about the SAP Policy and Appeal Process.](#)
 - **If you submitted a SAP appeal in the Fall 2022 semester and it was approved,** we will review your progress and ensure you are meeting the conditions of your approval before your spring aid can disburse. If you have not received an update by January 31st, please contact our office.
- **Middle Class Scholarship (MCS):** If you are eligible for the MCS, we are working to disburse the fall portion by the second week in January. Spring MCS awards will not disburse until late-February.

Reminder: Student Accounts' fee payment deadline is January 5th. You must pay your account balance, have a spring fee deferment, or set up a payment plan to avoid being dropped from courses for non-payment.



Zoom Phone Changes

The University recently went live with the Zoom phone.

With this transition, our phone system works differently, You can still wait on hold to speak with a team member, but the wait time is limited and you may experience higher call dropping. We wanted to share a couple of other options for getting in touch with us:
