PURPOSE:	The California State University (CSU) is committed to the protection of health and wellness of all students. To comply with this overarching goal, CSU campuses implement procedures to ensure that students are educated about and receive immunizations to prevent potentially serious and contagious diseases. Immunizations, Screening Requirements, and Recommendations are adopted from the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Immunization & Screening Recommendations for College Students.	
POLICY:	At California State University, Fresno, all incoming students starting in or after Fall 2023 will need to submit proof of immunizations and a TB Screening Questionnaire. Medical or religious exemptions are accepted to fulfill the requirement. This must be completed prior to registering for the second semester of courses.	
OTHER (IF NEEDED)	Immunization requirements vary based upon your age on the first day of the semester that you started Fresno State.
