Get Organized

Take Initiative by reading course materials, reach out to classmates and instructors, asking questions, and engaging in class discussions.



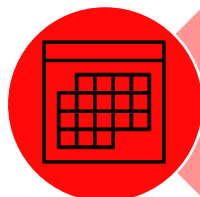
Hold Yourself Accountable
