

My Degree Plan - Roadmap

The first step before creating a plan is to access your major roadmap through the online catalog.

The roadmap identifies the specific set of courses a student must take in sequential order. Information on co- or prerequisites is listed along with other pertinent information to assist students in planning. Students are highly encouraged to see their advisor in their college advising center if they have questions.



Plan with a Roadmap – Access Online

There are two ways to access a roadmap through the online catalog. First, select the “degree roadmaps” link in the side bar. Roadmaps will be listed in alphabetical order under this selection. Search for and select the roadmap for your declared major.
