4. Am I limited to the number of units I can take over summer?

- a. Yes, undergraduate students are limited to 18 units, graduate students are limited to 16 units, and credential students are limited to 20 units. Students should follow the same excess unit process if requesting additional units. There is no additional unit increase based on GPA during summer semester.

5. Am I able to submit a Third Attempt Approval form or Excess Unit form (if needed) for Summer 24 courses?

- a. Yes, both forms are accepted for summer 2024 courses similar to fall and spring semesters. You can access the form or more information on the [Forms page](#) of our website.

6. What day do I need to drop by to get a full refund?

- a. Students **MUST** drop the class prior to the session starting to receive a full refund.

7. What are the summer fees for International or non-California resident students?

- a. Nonresident students pay an additional \$ 396 per unit plus mandatory campus fees.

8. If I drop a summer course after the course has already started can I get a refund? How much of a refund do I get back?

- a. Classes dropped as of the first day of the session starting or later will be subject to prorated tuition and mandatory fees. For more information on summer refunds, please visit the [Student Accounts website](#).
