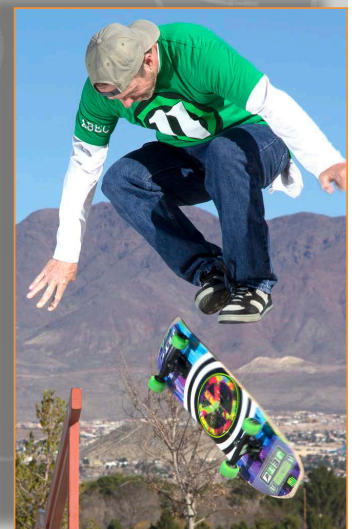


KEYNOTE SPEAKER

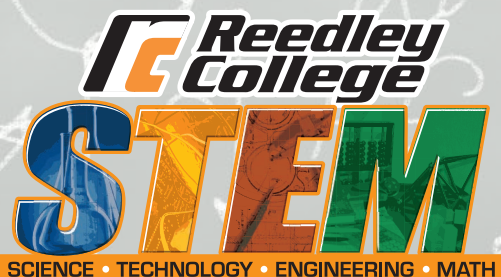
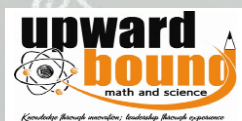
KEYNOTE SPEAKER
