### What is Upward Bound

Upward Bound (UB) is a TRIO program funded by the U.S. Department of Education. UB provides support and opportunities for participants to succeed in their precollege performance and ultimately in their higher education pursuits. UB serves high school students from low-income families and/or from families in which neither parent holds a bachelor's degree.

### Eligibility

- 9th or 10th grade high school students
- Low-income and/or first time generation
- Have a minimum cum 2.8 GPA
