Apply for Admission at Fresno State

What is the Veterans Education Program

1. Provides veterans with a parallel admission route into Fresno State
2. After successful completion of this program, student veterans may transition to matriculated status at Fresno State
3. All course sections are reserved exclusively for veterans. Veterans will take classes as a cohort
